STUDENT INTERNET ACCESS

CUSD provides students Internet and technology access, which may include iPad use, email, calendars, documents and file storage to support academic activities. Teachers provide guidance and direction on the appropriate use of the Internet and technology.  - Students who opt out of internet and technology access will be provided technology to access required, instructional material, such as state testing.
- This form must be resubmitted at the beginning of each school year.
