Dear Parent/Guardian/Community Member:

Beginning December 14, 2020 and through January 18, 2021, CUSD will transition to a remote learning model. This decision was not made in haste nor was it made without thoughtful consideration of the data.

- Each school site will send out a class schedule for remote learning.
- Tips for parents are posted on district web-site; a link posted on social media.
- On-site learning and support services for students that do not have access to a safe and productive environment to carry out remote learning will continue.
- We will offer iPad support on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:00 am to 12 noon at the District office.
- Food Service will continue as drive through Grab n Go Monday—Thursday except during winter break at high school cafeteria.
- Winter break is from December 21, 2020—January 4, 2021. The district will be closed.

**On-site Learning & Support Services:** If you believe your child needs a safe place to go during the day, please contact your child's home school to discuss if your child qualifies for this service.

- Please be advised that on-site learning opportunities and support services **will not** be teacher led classroom instruction. It will be in person support services such as student supervision and support for students in need from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm Monday through Thursday.
- The support and supervision services will be monitored by CUSD classroom paraprofessionals, bus drivers, and security personnel. Teachers will be teaching remotely. All supervising employees have a valid and current fingerprint clearance card.


