**PARENT PERMISSION ON MEDIA AND PUBLIC ACCESS**

Photographs and/or videotapes and /or interviews of your student may be requested by District sources, school sources, District/School Web site, or outside media. Parental permission must be recorded and on file before such sources are granted access to you student. Unless you direct otherwise, the district may disclose student “directory information” under limited circumstances. Directory information is information about a student that is generally not considered an invasion of privacy, such as a student’s name, address, photograph, dates of attendance activities and sports. The primary purpose of directory information is to allow the school to use this type of information in certain school publication, such as a playbill, athletic program, yearbook, honor roll or graduation program, the district does not release directory information for commercial purposes, other than to companies designated to sell school year books, class rings and other such items.
